Qualification Entry Requirements

Age Requirement: All international students must be at least 18 years of age or above at the time of the course commencement to study at UIA.

Academic Requirements:

Entry to this qualification is limited to those who:

- Have completed a Diploma or Advanced Diploma qualification in related fields of study and 2 years equivalent full-time relevant workplace experience at a significant level of leadership and management responsibility and/or complexity in an enterprise.

OR

- Have completed a Bachelor degree.

OR

- Have four years equivalent full-time relevant workplace experience at a significant level of leadership and management responsibility and/or complexity in an enterprise.

English Language Requirements:

- Eligible learner apart from the above eligibility specification, must also have minimum IELTS score of 6.0, PTE 50-58 or equivalent.

OR

- Evidence that they have studied in English for at least five years in Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Republic of Ireland, South Africa, United Kingdom or United States

OR

- Evidence that, within two years of their application date, they have successfully completed a Certificate IV or higher-level qualification, from the Australian Qualifications Framework.

Results older than 2 years are not accepted.

If students do not meet English Language requirements, learners will be asked to take further language, literacy and numeracy training. UIA will provide recommendations to accredited language testing facilities.
